in this summer world of ours.

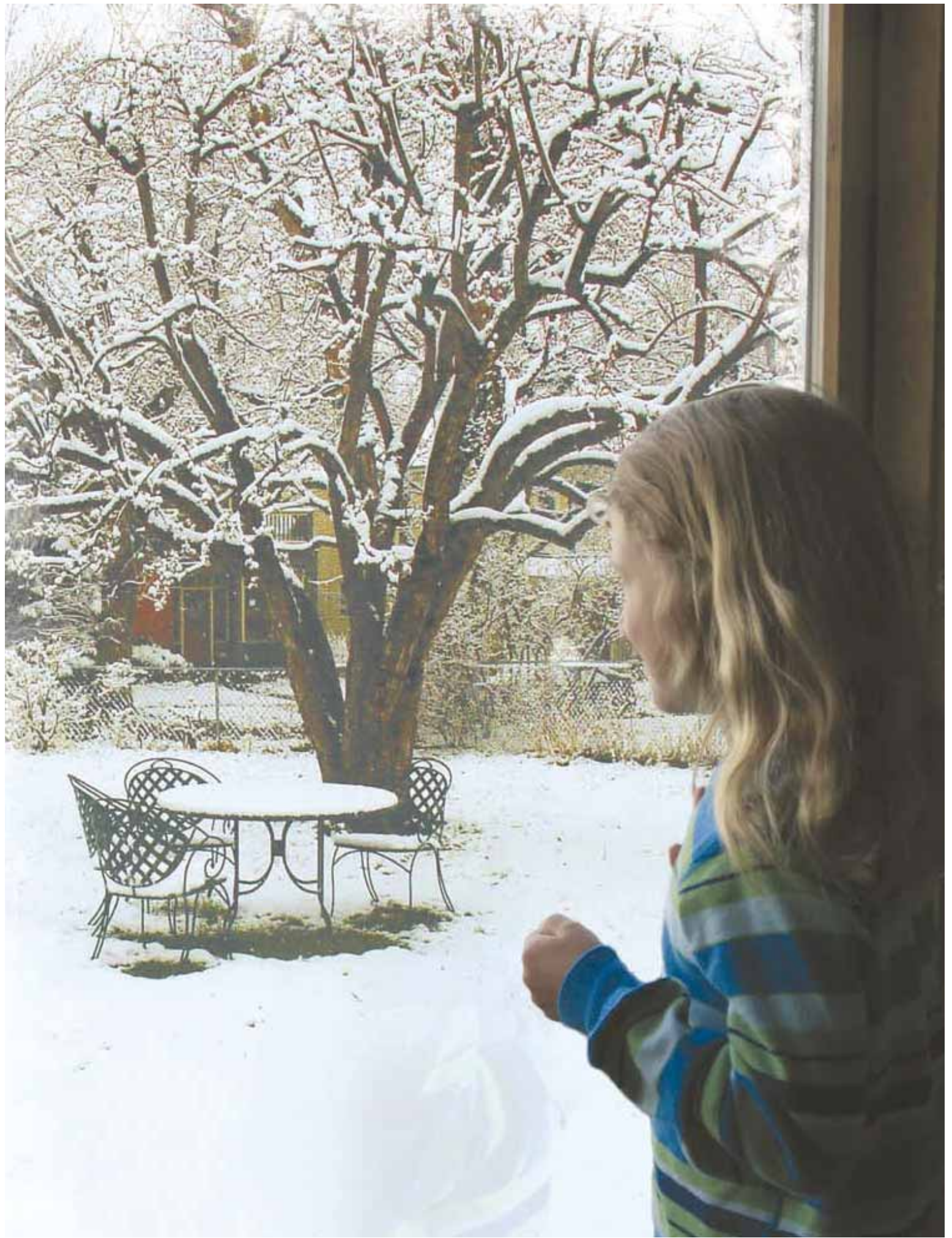

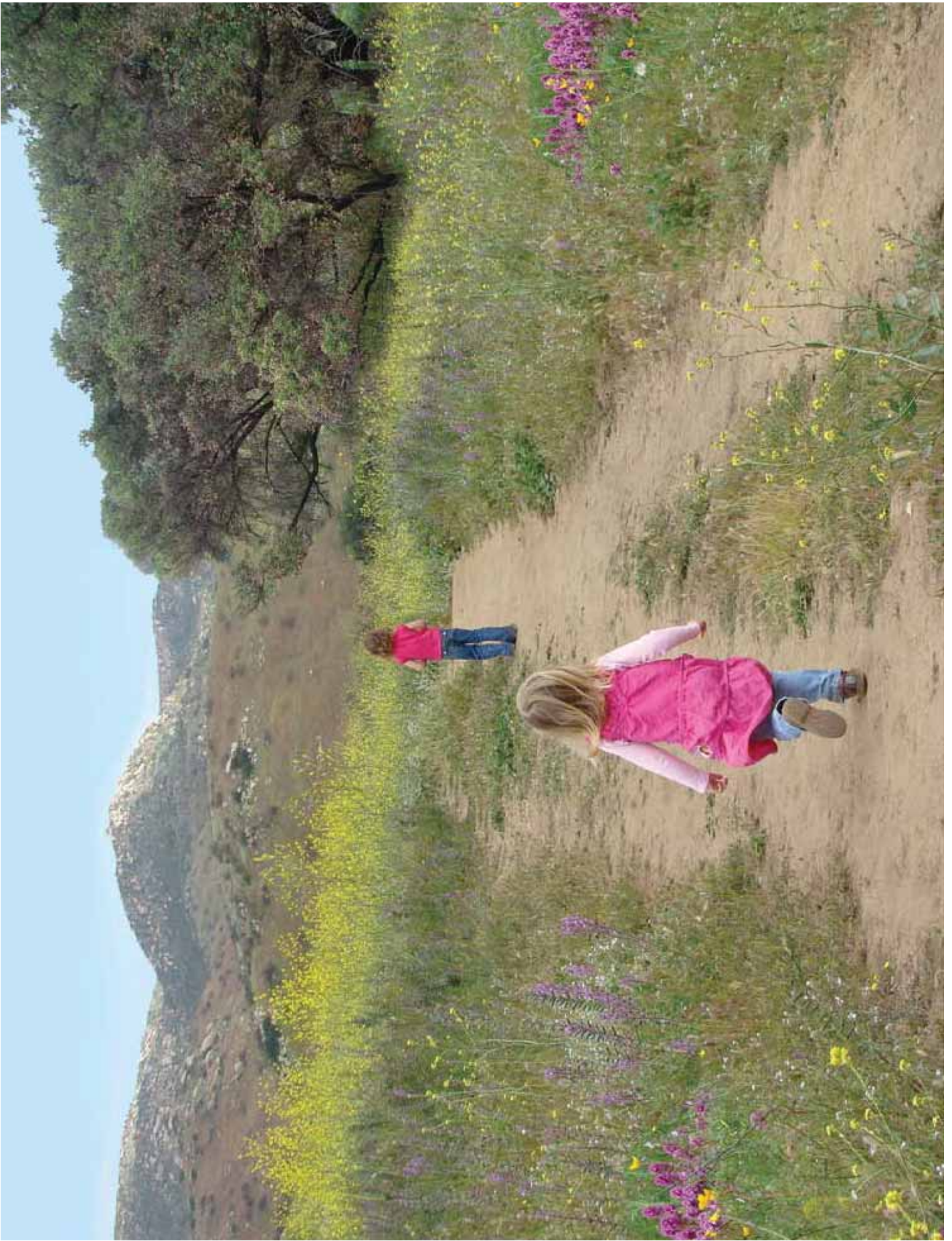
Winter Morning
